

IMGP Junior Goat Point Program

The IMGP Junior Goat Point Program shows are open to any junior Illinois exhibitor from five years to nineteen years (as of January 1 of the current year) exhibiting any goat they own on or before 1 May of the current year, unless goat is born on their farm after 1 May. The Point Series shows coincide with IMGP sponsored open shows. A junior exhibitor must show his/her own goat(s) unless exhibiting more than one goat in a single class. If exhibiting more than one goat in a single class, then another exhibitor may show that goat. This also includes championship classes.

For the breeding classes, goats must be registered in the junior exhibitor's name and be owned by the exhibitor before 1 May of the current year. Copies of the registration certificate for these entries must accompany your entry form, or must be presented at check-in.

Wethers must be owned and in the care of the exhibitor by 1 May of the current year.

Points will be awarded in both the wether classes and breeding classes. Each of the point shows have class points based on class placing, division champions (breeding stock), and overall champion.

The exhibitor or their parents/guardians must be a member of IMGP to participate in the IMGP Junior Goat Point Program. IMGP membership must be current before entries will earn points.

Points

Breeding Class points will be awarded based on placings, division champions, and overall champions in both the junior and open shows.

Grand Champion Overall: 25 Reserve Grand Champion Overall: 15
Division Champion: 10 Reserve Division Champion: 5
Class Points: if 10 goats in class (1st place-10 points, 2nd place-9 points, etc)

Wether Class points will be awarded based on placing in the junior show.

Grand Champion Overall: 25 Reserve Grand Champion Overall: 15
Class Points: if 10 goats in class (1st place-10 points, 2nd place-9 points, etc)

The points will be tracked during the junior show and will be posted on the IMGP website.

The goal of the Points Program is to award the top individual Junior IMGP exhibitors throughout the course of one year based on the total number of points accumulated during that year.

Prizes are awarded to the top five exhibitors at the annual meeting that scored the highest in each area (Breeding Classes & Wether Classes). The Junior IMGP Premier Exhibitor and Reserve Premier Exhibitor will receive belt buckles. Prizes will be awarded through 5th place.
